This week class assembly focused on the value of friendship and the story of David and Jonathan from the book of Samuel. The story is about friendship and standing up for others. Jonathan loves his best friend David, but also honours his father, King Saul. He stands up for his friendship and for David even though it puts him in a difficult situation

To stand up to something for a friend shows loyalty. It should be done wisely and with care. Sometimes your friend may need you to tell the truth and for you to help them overcome something rather than just standing with them. Sometimes 'standing with a friend' is about being together in a problem, rather than fixing it.

We are teaching the children that friendship takes many different forms but that recognising the value of friendship helps us to be a true and loyal friend, just as Jonathan was.
