Do you have a child born **between** 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020?

If so, you will need to apply for a place in a reception class in September 2024 for that child by the deadline of **15 January 2024**.



Please note: you will need to apply even if your child attends a school's nursery or preschool class. If a school is oversubscribed the fact that a child attends a school's nursery or pre-school, or a local nursery or pre-school, does not automatically guarantee a place at that school. Mobile Phone Policy for Years 5 & 6

We are aware that some children in years 5 and 6 use a mobile phone to communicate with parents if they are walking to and from school. All mobile phones must be switched off when children arrive on the school site and handed into the class teacher when entering their classroom. Phones are handed back at the end of the day. Children in years 5 and 6 were given a copy of this policy for parents and pupils to read, sign and hand back to their class teacher. If you need another copy of this letter, this can be asked for at the school office.



Safe Access to the school site

The main exit gate for the school car park is currently broken and out of use. Cars and large delivery vehicles are using the entrance gate to both enter and exit the school, significantly increasing risk in the area at the front of school . Please continue to use the safe pedestrian access when entering the school, situated on the Mongleath Road side or the Longfield side.
